Cuts & Grazes

STANDARD

- Use standard precautions, such as gloves, where available.
- Clean minor cuts and grazes with clean water or saline where appropriate.
- Cover the wound with a suitable sterile dressing or plaster.
- Keep the wound protected from dirt and contamination.
- Seek medical advice for wounds that are deep, dirty, painful, worsening, slow to heal, caused by a bite, or showing signs of infection.

DRESSINGS & BANDAGES

Dressings

ANZCOR GUIDANCE

STANDARD

- Control bleeding by applying direct pressure with a clean pad or dressing.
- Secure dressings firmly without restricting circulation.
- Elevate the injured limb where possible to help reduce swelling.
- Do not remove a dressing that has soaked through - apply another on top.
- Seek medical advice if bleeding does not stop or the wound is severe.

DRESSINGS & BANDAGES MODULE



Dressings

Combining dressings helps control bleeding while protecting the wound.



Conforming Bandages

Secure dressings and support injured limbs.



Triangular Bandages

Provide versatile support for limb injuries and slings.



TRAUMA

Trauma

STANDARD

- Apply firm, direct pressure to control major bleeding - use a tourniquet for life-threatening limb bleeding if direct pressure fails.
- Keep the person warm and still, and monitor for signs of shock.
- Do not remove embedded objects - stabilise them in place.
- Call 000 immediately for serious injuries.

TRAUMA MODULE



Trauma Dressings

Supports management of life-threatening limb bleeding when direct pressure is insufficient.



Emergency Blankets

Help maintain body temperature and reduce the risk of shock.



Nitrile Gloves

Support hygiene during high-risk trauma care.

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Eyecare

ANZCOR GUIDANCE

STANDARD

- Do not rub the eye - this can worsen injury or drive a foreign body deeper.
- Irrigate the eye with clean water or saline to flush out foreign bodies or chemical splashes.
- Cover the affected eye with a sterile pad if irrigation is not possible or the eye is injured.
- Seek medical advice for chemical exposure, persistent pain, vision changes, or embedded objects.

EYECARE MODULE



Eye Wash Saline

Helps flush foreign bodies and chemical splashes from the eye.



Sterile Eye Pads

Protect the eye when irrigation is not appropriate or the eye requires covering.



BURNS

Burns

STANDARD

- Cool the burn under cool running water for 20 minutes where possible.
- Use commercial cooling gels afterwards, or when running water is not available.
- Remove jewellery or tight items near the burn, unless stuck to the skin.
- Do not apply ice, creams, butter or powders.
- Seek urgent care for serious, large, deep, electrical or chemical burns.

BURNS MODULE

Provide immediate cooling relief when running water is unavailable.

SNAKE BITE

Snake Bite

STANDARD

- Keep the person calm and still - movement accelerates venom spread.
- Apply pressure immobilisation: bandage firmly from the bite site upward, immobilise the limb with a splint, and keep the person lying down.
- Do not cut, suck or wash the bite site - residual venom on the skin aids identification.
- Call 000 immediately.

SNAKE BITE MODULE



Medstock Snake Bite Bandage

Allow rapid application of pressure immobilisation bandaging.



Pin-less Compression

Design to ensure even, firm compression to prevent breaking under firm compression.
